Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

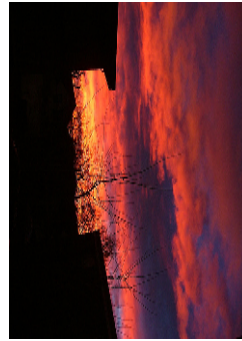
1. Review the major bio-psycho-social factors that shape sexual response.

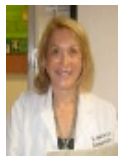
Course Fees

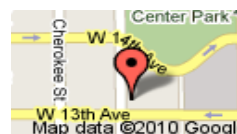
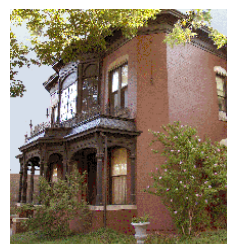
Richard Siegel, MS, LMHC, CST, AASECT
