Richard Siegel, MS, LMHC, CAP, CST, AASECT

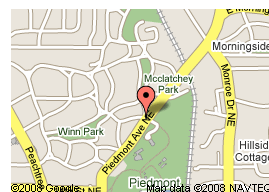
